What is a cookie?

We use cookies on this website. A cookie is a simple small file that is sent along with pages from this website [and/or Flash applications] and stored by your browser on your device (computer/phone/tablet). The information stored therein can be sent back to our servers on a subsequent visit.

Use of permanent cookies

With the help of a permanent cookie, we can recognize you when you visit our website again. The website can therefore be specially tailored to your preferences. Even if you have given permission to place cookies, we can remember this by means of a cookie. This means you don't have to repeat your preferences, saving you time and making our website more pleasant to use. You can delete permanent cookies via your browser settings.

Use of session cookies

With the help of a session cookie, we can see which parts of the website you viewed during this visit. We can therefore adapt our service as much as possible to the surfing behavior of our visitors. These cookies are automatically deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

Our own tracking cookies

With your consent, we place a cookie on your equipment, which can be requested as soon as you visit a website from our network. This allows us to find out that in addition to our website, you have also been to the relevant other website(s) from our network. The profile built up in this way is not linked to your name, address, email address, etc., but only serves to match advertisements to your interests, so they are as relevant to you as possible.

Google Analytics

A cookie is placed on our website by the American company Google, as part of the "Analytics" service. We use this service to track and get reports on how visitors use the website. Google may provide this information to third parties if Google is legally obliged to do so, or insofar as third parties process the information on behalf of Google. We have no influence on this. We have/do not have allowed Google to use the obtained analytics information for other Google services.

The information that Google collects is anonymized as much as possible. Your IP address is explicitly not provided. The information is transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Standard Contractual Clauses are therefore part of Google's terms and conditions.

Our website includes buttons to promote ("like") or share ("tweet") web pages on social networks like Facebook and LinkedIn. These buttons work through pieces of code that come from Facebook or LinkedIn respectively. Cookies are placed through this code. We have no influence on this.
